Asymptomatic Testing for Interstate Drivers

As has been previously stated, all Victorian interstate drivers can now have an asymptomatic COVID-19 test and not have to quarantine after the test.

This change in Victorian COVID directions enables interstate heavy vehicle drivers to be able to meet the Border requirements where an asymptomatic test must be evidenced before crossing into another state.

The Victorian Government has not provided our industry with a list of providers nor has the Department of Health and Human Services informed the clinics on their website of this change in protocols.

The VTA has been able to ensure that private clinics are able to receive interstate drivers for asymptomatic testing.

The asymptomatic test for Interstate drivers can be Bulk Billed by the service provider.

Most clinics will not need an appointment.

The driver will need to have a copy of their Drivers Licence, Border Permits and their Medicare number.

A test completion certificate will be provided by the clinic.

The results of the test will be provided to the driver directly.
