Victorian Premier Daniel Andrews to address VTA *Breakfast with the Premier* event

The Victorian Transport Association has secured Victorian Premier Daniel Andrews to meet with and address VTA members, associate members, sponsors and other freight and transport industry stakeholders at a special *Breakfast with the Premier* event next month.

The breakfast marks the return of the popular ministerial breakfast event series the Association has held for many years, and which has been disrupted by COVID restrictions since 2020.

VTA CEO Peter Anderson said the Association was honoured that the Premier had accepted the invitation to address members and other guests.

“In a state election year where freight transport and infrastructure are shaping up as hotly contested issues, this is a great opportunity to meet and hear directly from the Premier and have the opportunity to help shape Victorian public policy,” Anderson said.
